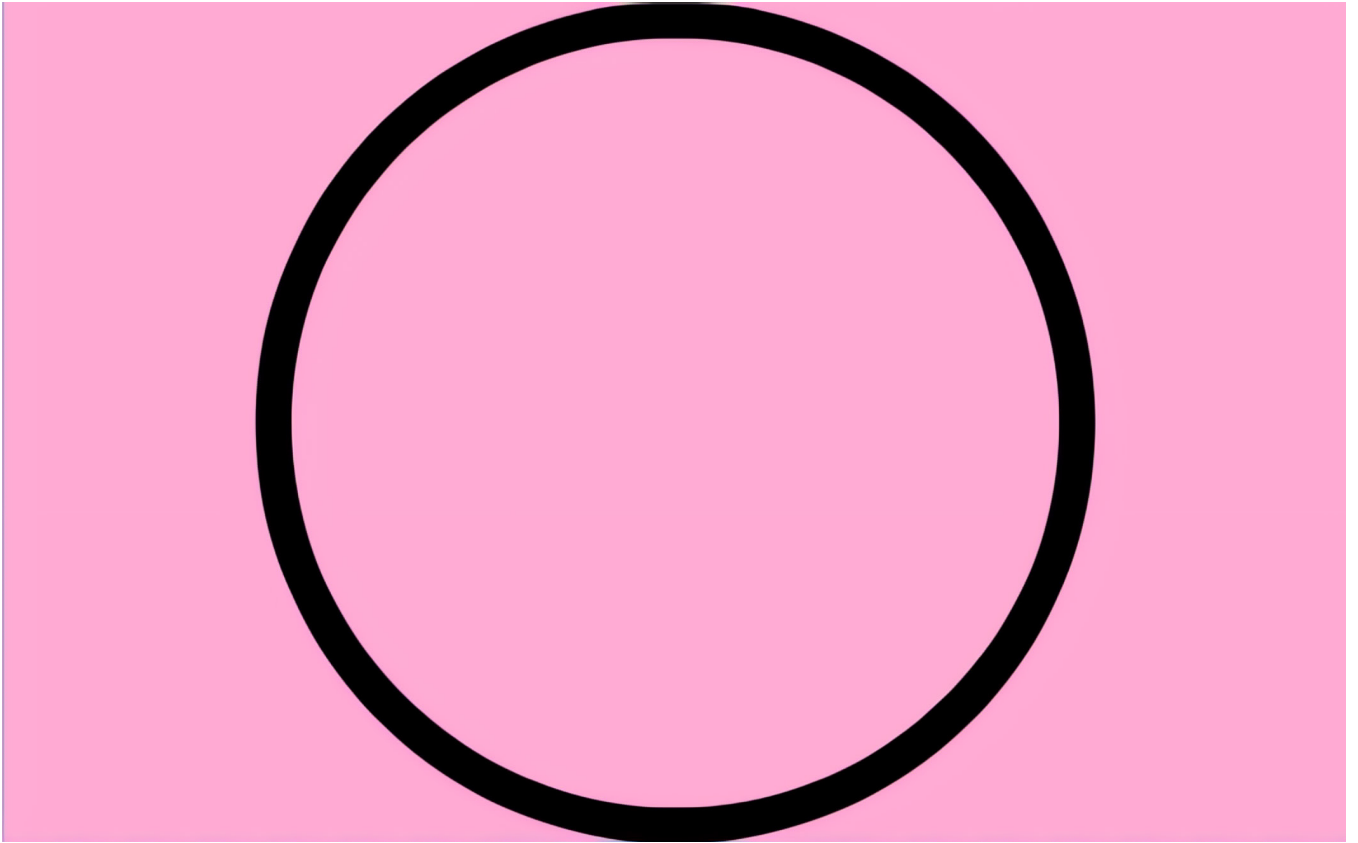
A star is a shape that has five sides and five corners.



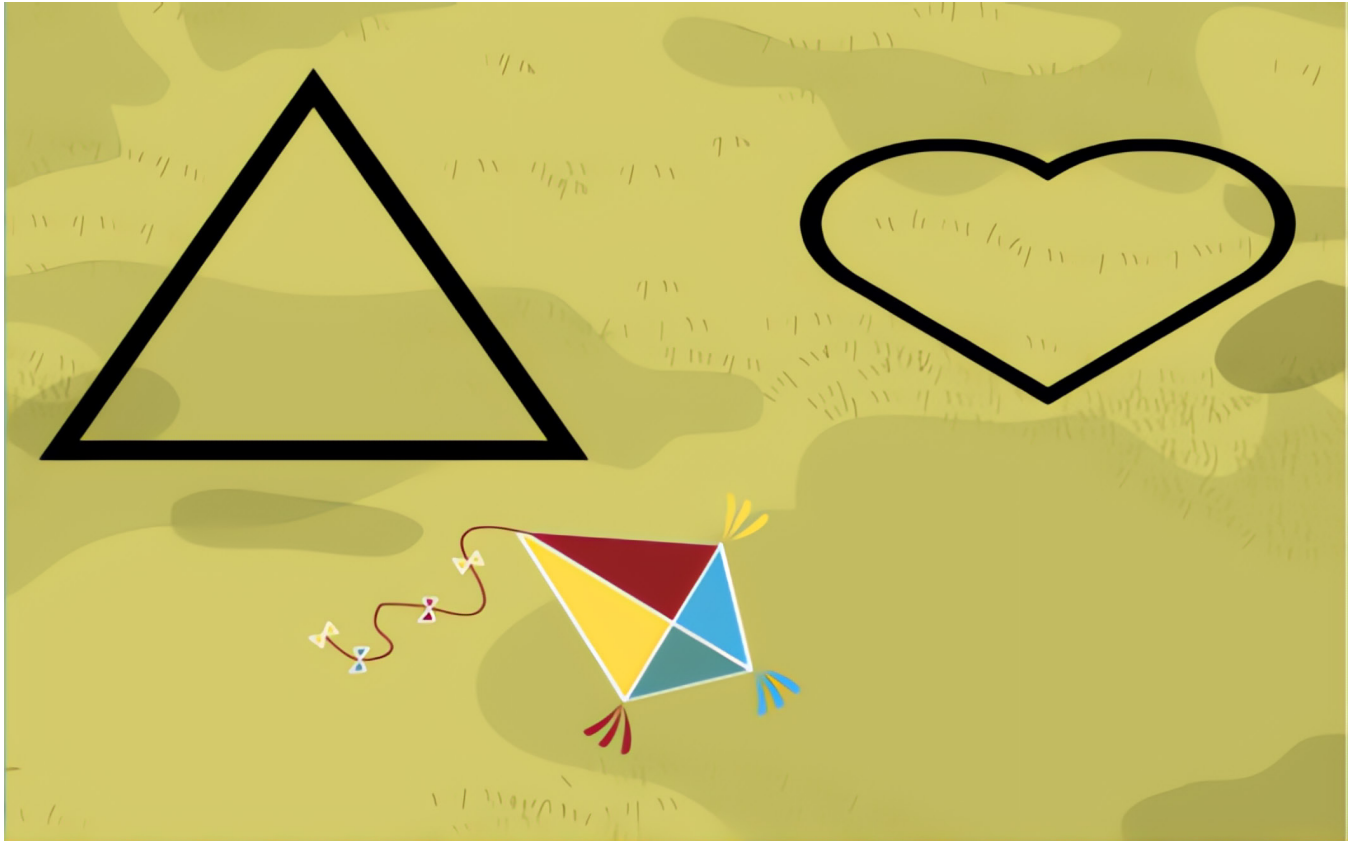

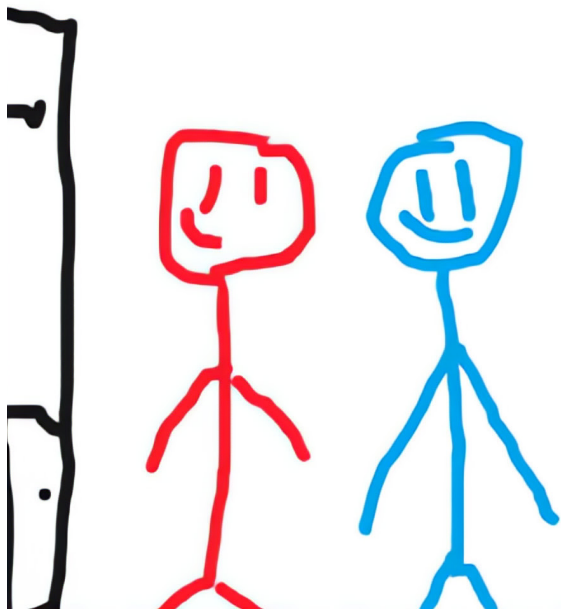
So one day, there was a cool guy on a hoverboard, He was red and his hoverboard was red.



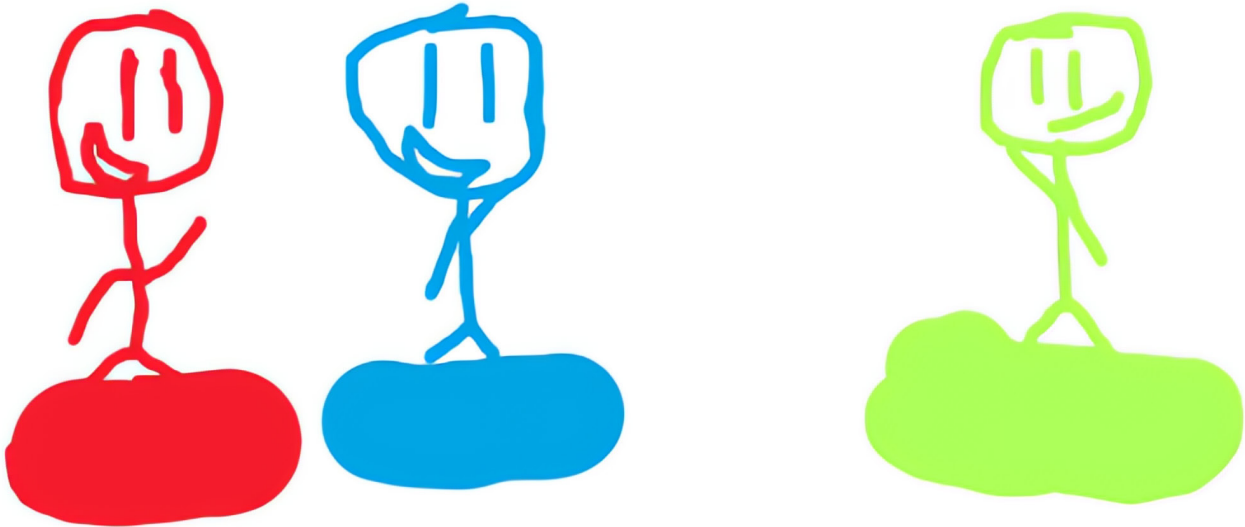
And then he saw a cool blue guy, Once again he was blue, and his hoverboard was blue.



They bought cool stuff at the store.



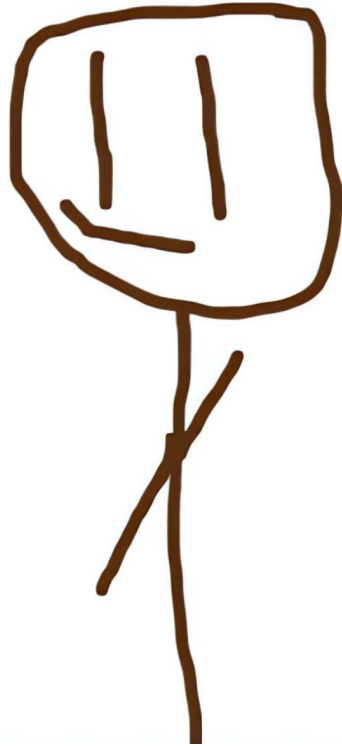
And then when they got out.

guy.



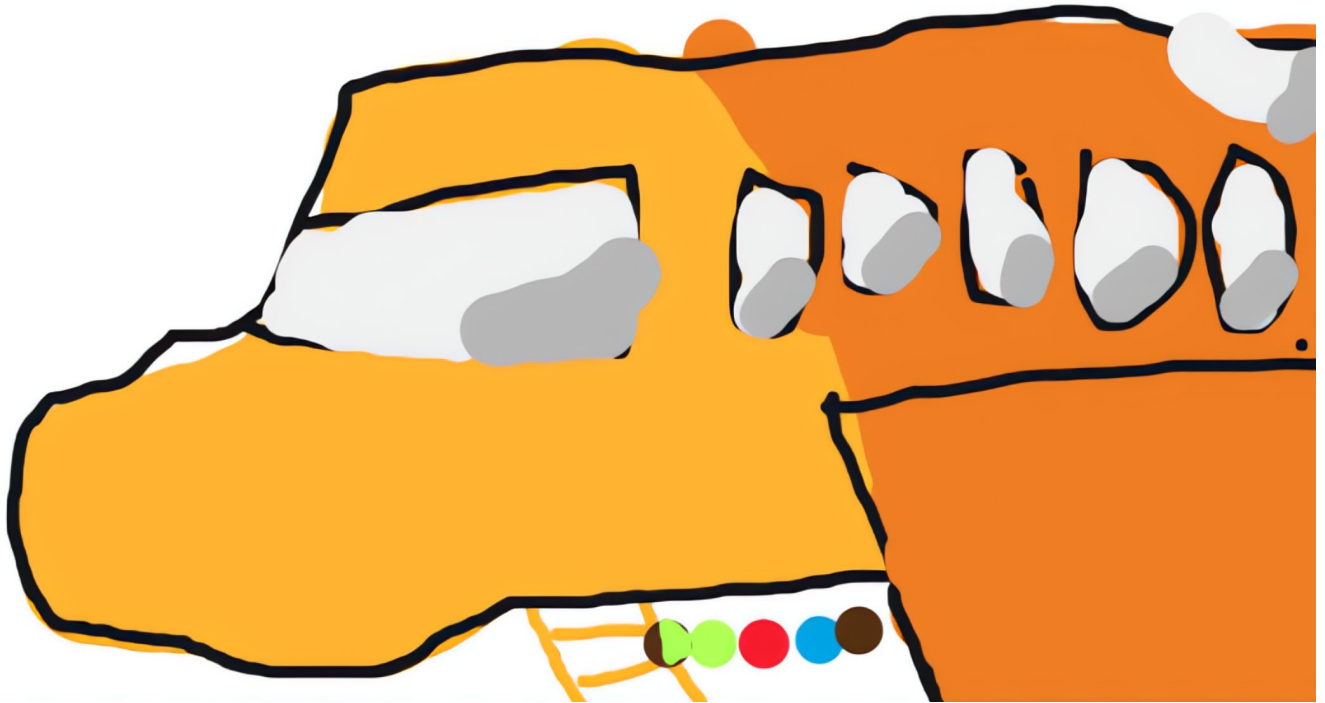
and also brown hoverboard guy!



they all listened to songs they liked, at red's house, witch is really good.



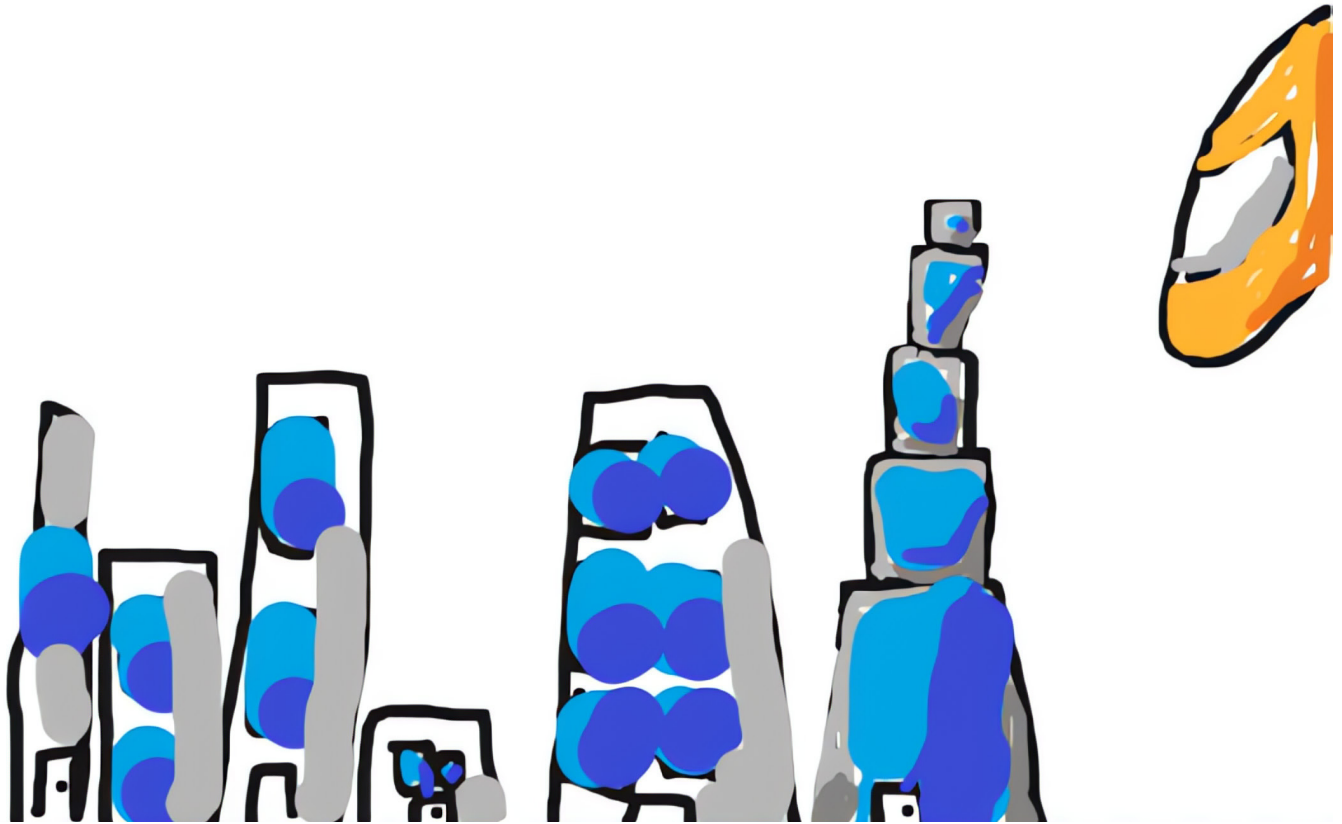
They also started a youtube channel and,

They went to Dubai with the gold jet.



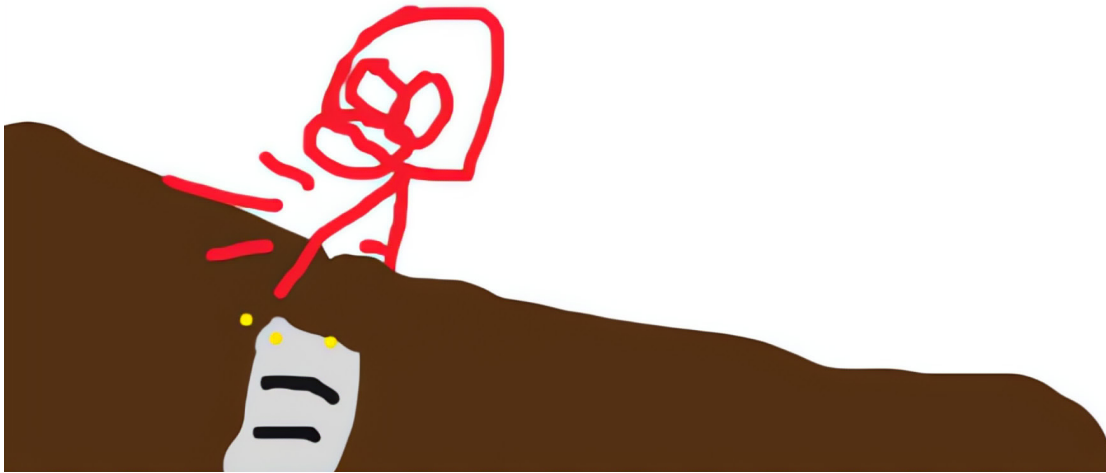
after they went to Dubai they saw the cast of the mixed dimensions which was made by the author.

And on August 2 red got his new nendorid.



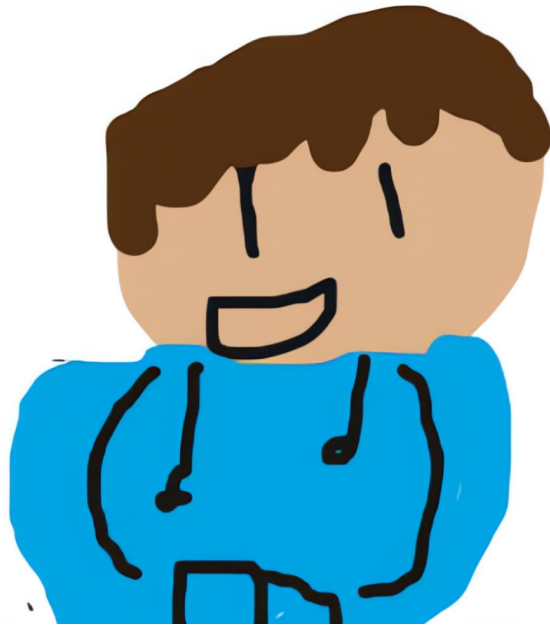
