ADMINISTRATION

SUBJECT: Concept and Roles in Administration

The County Superintendent of Schools is the executive officer of the County Board of Education, and shall administer the policies adopted by the County Board of Education under the powers and duties accorded to it under provisions of law.

The County Superintendent of Schools may initiate and carry on any program, activity, or may otherwise act on any manner which is not in conflict with or inconsistent with, or preempted by, any law and which is not in conflict with the purposes for which county offices were established.

The County Superintendent of Schools serves as an elected state officer whose responsibility it is to administer numerous "arm of the state" duties required by state law.
