



PK Dance Standards

Creating = Conceiving and developing new artistic ideas and work.

Creating—<u>Anchor Standard 1</u>: Generate and Conceptualize Artistic Ideas and Work

- a. Respond in movement to a variety of sensory stimuli (e.g., music/ sound, visual, tactile).
- b. Find a different way to do several basic locomotor and nonlocomotor movements.

Creating—<u>Anchor Standard 2</u>: Organize and Develop Artistic Ideas and Work

- a. Improvise dance that starts and stops on cue.
- b. Engage in dance experiences moving alone or with a partner.

Creating—Anchor Standard 3: Refine and Complete Artistic Work

Respond to suggestions for changing movement through guided improvisational experiences.

Presenting/Performing/Producing = Realizing artistic ideas and work through interpretation and presentation.

Presenting—<u>Anchor Standard 4</u>: Select, Analyze, and Interpret Artistic Work for Presentation

- a. Identify and demonstrate directions for moving the body in general space (e.g., forward, backwards, sideways, up, down, and turning) and finding and returning to a place in space.
- b. Identify speed of movement as fast or slow. Move to varied rhythmic sounds at different tempi.
- c. Move with opposing dynamics.

Presenting—<u>Anchor Standard 5</u>: Develop and Refine Artistic Techniques and Work for Presentation

- a. Demonstrate basic full body locomotor, non locomotor movement, and body patterning with spatial relationships.
- b. Move in general space and start and stop on cue while maintaining personal space.
- c. Identify and move body parts and repeat movements upon request.

Presenting—<u>Anchor Standard 6</u>: Convey Meaning Through the Presentation of Artistic Work

- a. Dance for others in a designated area or space.
- b. Use a prop as part of a dance.

Responding = Understanding and evaluating how the arts convey meaning.

Responding—Anchor Standard 7: Perceive and Analyze Artistic Work

- a. Identify a movement in a dance by repeating it.
- b. Demonstrate an observed or performed dance movement.

Responding—Anchor Standard 8: Interpret Intent and Meaning in Artistic Work

Observe a movement and share impressions.

Responding—Anchor Standard 9: Apply criteria to evaluate artistic work. Find a movement in a dance that was fun to watch. Repeat it and explain why it is fun to watch and do.

Connecting= Relating artistic ideas and work with personal meaning and external context.

Connecting—Anchor Standard 10: Synthesize and Relate Knowledge and Personal Experiences to Make Art

- a. Recognize an emotion expressed in dance movement that is watched or performed.
- b. Observe a dance work. Identify and imitate a movement from the dance, and ask a question about the dance.

Connecting—Anchor Standard 11: Relate Artistic Ideas and Works with Societal, Cultural, and Historical Context to Deepen Understanding Show a dance movement experienced at home or elsewhere.
