The Center for Teacher Preparation is proud to offer the Education Specialist Intern Program, which allows candidates to earn an Education Specialist Instruction in either Mild to Moderate Support Needs or Extensive Support Needs. The program empowers teachers to successfully deliver high-quality, engaging content for all learners through a supportive, team approach with a balance of theoretical and application based learning experiences. The coursework and practicum are designed for those who are interested in public school employment in the following counties: Riverside, Inyo, Mono, or San Bernardino.

We are excited to provide a rolling admissions process for an accelerated program that is four semesters in length. Candidates can start their internship immediately upon securing a job and receive exceptional support to successfully serve their students.

### PROGRAM FEES

There are multiple payment options and grants available to help candidates pay for the program. Those enrolled will not pay the program fee until they have secured a teaching position in a public school within Riverside, Inyo, Mono, or San Bernardino Counties.

#### 1. TRADITIONAL: \$11,925

For teachers without a teaching credential. Will secure employment as an Education Specialist teacher. (4 semesters)

- Application: \$100
- Pre-Service Coursework: \$900
- Program Fee: \$10,600  
(or \$2,650 per semester)
- CTC Fees: \$325

#### 2. ADVANCED: \$5,725

For candidates who hold an existing clear General Education Teaching Credential and want to obtain a Preliminary Education Specialist Teaching Credential. Has secured employment as an Education Specialist teacher. (2 semesters)

- Application: \$100
- Program Fee: \$5,300  
(or \$2,650 per semester)
- CTC Fees: \$325

### OTHER PROGRAM BENEFITS AND SUPPORTS

- The Center for Teacher Preparation offers discounted *Teachers Test Prep* courses.
- Once candidates are officially enrolled as interns in the program, they can apply for the Golden State Teach Grant.
- Those interested in long-term subbing only can take courses for the Teaching Permit for Statutory Leave (TPSL).

#### 3. BRIDGE PROGRAM: \$425

The bridge program allows current California educators with a teaching position and a clear Education Specialist Teaching Credential to update their credential to the newest authorization.
