Board Bylaw 9220 County Board of Education Elections

BYLAWS OF THE BOARD

SUBJECT: County Board of Education Elections

The Riverside County Board of Education (County Board) shall consist of seven members whose terms shall be staggered so that, as nearly as practicable, one half of the members shall be elected at each regular County Board election. (Education Code 1000, 1007)

County Board election procedures shall be conducted in accordance with the California Education Code and the California Elections Code.

Statement of Qualifications

The County Board shall assume no part of the cost of printing, handling, translating or mailing candidate statements.

The Secretary of the Board shall notify the County Clerk of this policy on or before the 125th day prior to each election of County Board members.

Qualifications for Holding Office

Any registered voter is eligible to be a member of the County Board if that person is an elector of the trustee area to be represented and is not legally disqualified from holding civil office. (Education Code 1000, 1006)

Tie Votes in Board Member Elections

Whenever a tie makes it impossible to determine which of two or more candidates has been elected to the County Board, the Board shall immediately notify the County Elections Board and the Candidates who received the tie vote for purpose of scheduling the time and a place where lots shall be cast to determine the winner.
