BYLAWS OF THE BOARD

SUBJECT: Expulsion Appeals

The Riverside County Board of Education will hear an expulsion appeal when a pupil is expelled by a local district governing board and the parent/guardian files an appeal to the County Board of Education. The County Board of Education shall hold a hearing thereon and render its decision. The order shall become final when rendered.

The decision of the County Board of Education shall be final and binding upon the pupil and upon the governing board of the school district.
