#### **STUDENTS**

#### **SUBJECT: Student and Family Privacy Rights**

The County Board of Education and County Superintendent of Schools believe that personal information concerning students and their families should be kept private in accordance with law.

The County Superintendent or designee shall consult with parents/guardians regarding the development and adoption of this policy.

### **Collection of Personal Information for Marketing Purposes**

The County Office of Education authorizes staff to administer or distribute survey instruments to students that are designed for the purpose of collecting personal information for marketing or for selling that information. The County Superintendent or designee shall ensure that these instruments are administered in accordance with law and administrative regulation.

In addition, the County Superintendent or designee may collect, disclose, or use a student's individually identifiable information, including his/her name, parent/guardian's name, home or other physical address, or telephone number for the purpose of marketing or selling that information or providing the information to others for that purpose.

However, the County Office of Education shall not use surveys to collect social security numbers or the last four digits of social security numbers, or information or documents regarding citizenship or immigration status, of students or their families. (Education Code 234.7, 49076.7)
